(A) Carried forward Suggestions:-


Carried forward suggestions are as:-

The meeting was presided over by Dr. Dev Raj Sharma, Principal.


The following matters were discussed during the meeting:

- 3) It was recommended and proposed by the members to conduct Career.


guidance and placement activities in the College. It was proposed to invite the specialised keynote speakers to address the students in the upcoming few weeks.



⇒ There is urgent requirement of medicinal plants, local shrubs, herbs and flower beds for botanical Garden. proper fencing of Garden is also required.


⇒ Space must be allocated for the articles, musical instruments & other local antique associated with the culture & heritage of local region.


⇒ It has been noticed that there are very less no. of students enrolled in commerce stream, there is a need of motivation to increase the strength.
