**Classrooms:** The College has sufficient class rooms (12) and lecture theatres (6) with a seating capacity of more than 100 students in each classroom/lecture theatre. In addition to said facilities,



there is a large hall-cum-classroom which can accommodate 400 students and is used for larger classes.





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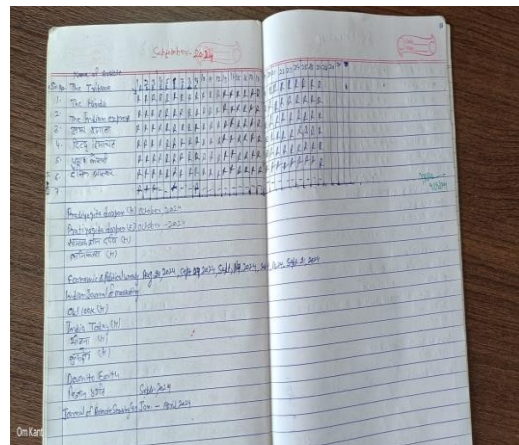
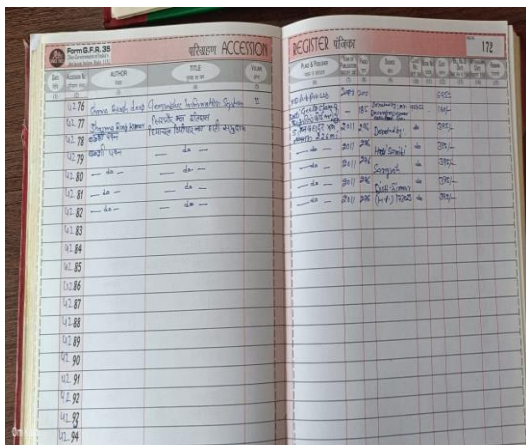

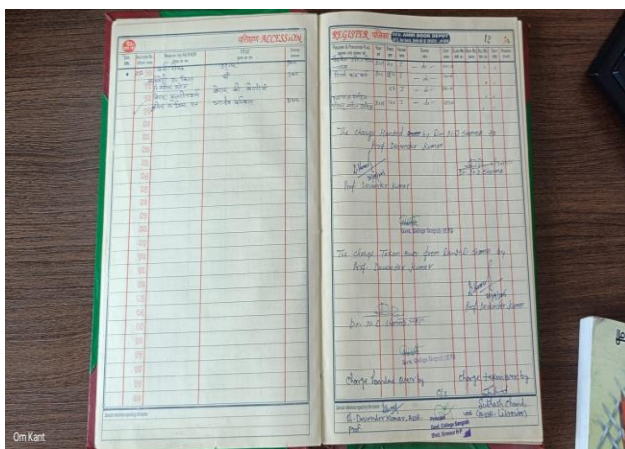
keeping bags and books. All classrooms are fitted with large boards.

## i. Whether adequate books print books are available.

College Library contains total collection of 4561 books of various subjects. Nine periodicals and six newspapers have also been subscribed.



That means 900 books per 100 students are available in the college library.





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The library was fully automated in the year 2019-20 with SOUL 2.0 Software purchased from Infflibnet Centre Gandhinagar for wide



scope of library activities like acquisition, cataloguing

and circulation with provision for renewal and serial control. The library also includes a hall of seating capacity of 58 students for study. There is a separate study room for faculty members which has seating capacity of 10. The library also contains some rare manuscripts called "Sancha" in Pahari dialect which have ancient lores, chants and astrolog

### ICT System:

1 e-Podium, 2 touch screen flat display units of 65 inches each, 2 amplifiers, 2 horns, 4 large and 2 small speakers and 8 mikes.



Since, all classrooms are not equipped with ICT facilities, therefore, 304 Smart Class Room, S-5, and Language Lab-cum-Conference Hall are used by the faculty members for specific areas of their courses on need basis with mutual arrangement and as such for flexibility and optimum utilization said rooms are not assigned for specific courses/classes in the Time-Table.



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The campus is equipped with an electronic board for display of information. The campus is partially Wi-Fi enabled. The entire campus has

been brought under CCTV surveillance by installing 26 CCTV cameras in the college campus at strategic locations with a control room in the Principal's office.



i. % of teachers using ICT facilities:

-As college has four LCD Panels of which 3 panels are being used for regular teaching except Language lab. Out of all staff these panels are used by 10 teachers which is 71% of the teachers using these service

according to the period allotted.

ii. No of students benefited from ICT facilities :- 75% of students are getting benefitted from these facilities in the college.





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The college has provided for the specially-abled student way and ramp at the entrance of the college gate.



A separate toilet for handicap students has been kept and used by only those specially-abled students.

**5. The Institution has adequate facilities for sports, games (indoor, outdoor), gymnasium, yoga centre etc.**

**Playground:** There is a playground in campus for outdoor games and sports. Its area is 2600 sq metres. It was made at the time of establishment of the college. The college is working with the revenue authorities for the demarcation of the land so that the playground as well as the entire college can be fenced properly. Usage rate of the playground is 60 students per day.

**Athletics:** For race events 6 lanes of 100 meter track are usually prepared in the playground.

Another portion of the playground is used for jumping and throwing events.

**Volleyball:** A part of the playground is used as a separate volleyball court.



**Cricket:** When other games/activities are not taking place, the playground is usually used for playing cricket.

**Badminton:** An outdoor badminton court has been prepared in the courtyard of the college at the time of its establishment. It has a length of 30 feet and breadth of 22 feet. So that the classes are not disturbed, games are allowed after 3:00 PM. Average usage rate is 20 students per day. A blue-print for an indoor badminton court has also been carved out.



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**Table Tennis:** An indoor facility for table tennis is available. Length of this hall is 32 feet and breadth 26 feet. Two TT tables are placed here. It was made functional at the time of establishment of the college. Average usage rate is 30 students per day.

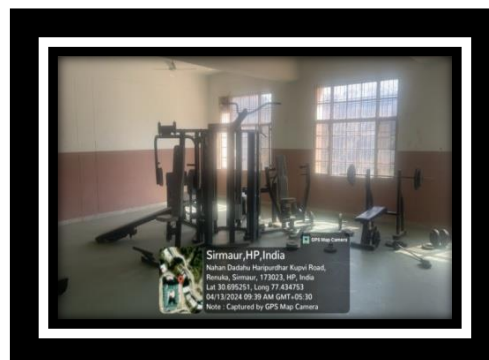
**Chess:** Chess boards are available. Average usage rate is 20 students per day.

**Carrom Board:** Five Carrom boards are available. Average usage rate is 20 students per day.

**Gymnasium:** The college has a multi-station gym which was set up in the year 2015-16. It was further upgraded in the year 2017. Average usage rate is 22 students per day.

**Yoga Centre:** The college has a hall for Yoga. Its length is 32 feet and breadth 26 feet. Yoga is also included as a course in Physical Education. Average usage rate is 30 students per day.

**NSS:** NSS unit is functional in the college. NSS volunteers enthusiastically take part in various social, cultural and community



related activities. NSS has a room allotted in the campus for day-to-day functioning. In 2023-24, one hundred students are enrolled in NSS.

## ICT System:

1 e-Podium, 2 touch screen flat display units of 65 inches each, 2 amplifiers, 2 horns, 4 large and 2 small speakers and 8 mikes.

To foster creativity, horn writing skills, build confidence and to develop communication skills, the students take part in various activities like writing articles for the college magazine, competing in intra and inter college competitions in essay and slogan writing and in intra and inter college debate and declamation contests. Such activities are organised throughout the year by the college.







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**6. Hostel Facility:** The college has no auditorium but it has girls hostel which has the capacity to accommodate 120 girls each session. The building has three stories consisting of 12 rooms each. In ground floor there is a common room, dining room and residence for hostel warden.



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The college has only principal residence available which is adjacent to the college building.

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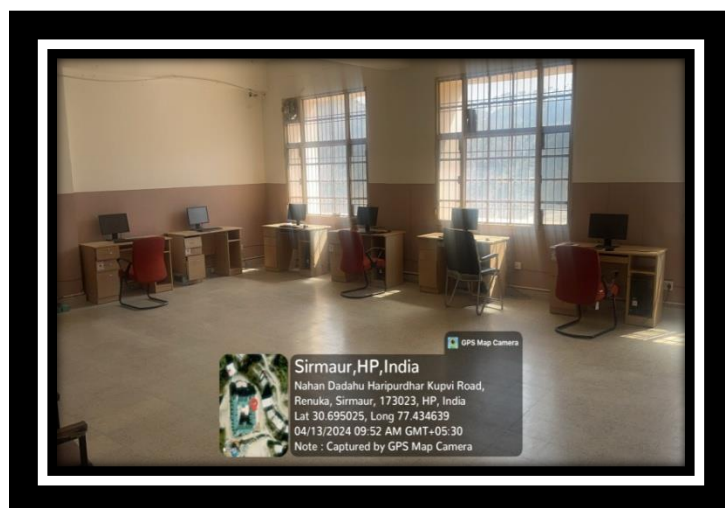
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## i. Adequate number of computers:
