Teaching Learning (SCORE – 140)

1. Mode of Teaching (Max. Score - 25)

- i). Lecture method only (NIL):- This type of teaching is very rare as Technology based teaching has become an integral part of modern day college level teaching.
- ii) **Technology based teaching only (06) or Blended Teaching (12)**: Most of the teaching is carried out in Blended form i.e. both Lecture method and Technology based.



- iii) **Flipped Classroom (08)**: This is a teaching method that inverts the traditional classroom model by having students learn material before class and then apply it in class. The teachers provide the teaching material in soft copy format well in advance and the students go through it before it is taught in the class. This helps in better understanding of the topic when it is taught
- iv) As per need of different groups of students (06): As the students belong to different strata of society hence their needs are also different. Hence special efforts are made to cater to the needs of different groups of students. Following is the criteria followed for this type of teaching-

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



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


परिचयः हम गजवा के बारे में जानेंगे की इसका नाम गजवा क्यों पड़ा. यहाँ की क्लदेवी व कलदेवता कौन है? यहाँ कितने सम्दाय के लोग रहते हैं. यहाँ की भौगोलिक स्थिति क्या थी और यहाँ पर सर्वप्रथम कौन आया और वर्तमान समय में उनके वंशज कौन हैं?

ऐतिहासिक पृष्ठभूमि: सर्वप्रथम हरियाणा के बरेली नामक स्थान से शेर सिंह (शेरू) यहाँ पर आये. वहन से स्थानान्तरण का कारण सिक्खों के लगातार आक्रमण थे. जिस कारण वह डर कर बोलोटी आया. क्छ समय के पश्चात् वहां पर एक लड़की द्वारा पूरे गाँव में आग लगा दी गयी. जिस कारण वह वापिस अपने मूल स्थान हरियाणा आ गये. उनके प्त्र का नाम नाथिया था. गजवा में शेरसिंह के समय उनकी धोची (फील्ड एरिया) थी. नाथिया के वापिस गजवा आने से पहले ठुंडू नामक व्यक्ति ने गजवा पर कब्जा कर लिया था. अपनी जमीन वापिस हासिल करने के लिए नाथिया ने नाहन के राजा के पास म्कदमा दाखिल किया. उस समय नम्बरदारी डसाकना की थी. नाहन के राजा द्वारा उन्हें अदालत में पेश होने के समन काटे गये. सभी सब्त नथिया के पक्ष में होने के कारण राजा ने ठुंडू को गजवा छोड़ने के आदेश दिये. लगातार लड़ाई और जानवरों के डर के कारण नाथिया वहां अकेले रहने में सक्षम नही था जिस कारण उसने सिंघड़े से सिंघड़ान. मुनाणे से मुनवाण, कलणे से कलनिया एवं तान्दियों से तुंदवाल को अपने साथ गजवा गाँव में रहने के लिए लाया

नामकरण: इस जगह का पूर्व नाम क्या है इस विषय में गाँव के लोगों में भी मतभेद हैं. गाँव में लोगों का मानना है की गजवा शब्द का शाब्दिक अर्थ घर के पीछे होता है. इसके अतिरिक्त गाँव के पीछे वाले क्षेत्र में घना वनक्षेत्र होने और जानवरों की गूँज के कारण भी इसे गजवा नाम दिया गया है.

कुलदेवी-कुलदेवता: यहाँ की कुलदेवी कुचियाट को पंजाह नामक गाँव से व् कुलदेवता शिरगुल को भलोना गाँव से लाया गया है.

- ii) **Students satisfaction :-** Approximately, more than 62% of the students were satisfied in this survey.




iii) Action on feedback :-
